Cell Phones

- Cell phones are not permitted during academic hours 7:40am -2:30 pm and should remain in the student's locker. Students who violate this policy will have their cell phones confiscated until the close of the next school day and receive a demerit.
- Possession of a cell phone during a class administering an exam will be in violation of academic dishonesty.
- Cell phones are not permitted in the locker room at ANY time. Students who violate this policy will have their cell phones confiscated for one week and receive a detention. Cell phone must be picked up by a parent after one week has passed.

Cell Phones

- Cell phones are not permitted during academic hours 7:40am -2:30 pm and should remain in the student's locker. Students who violate this policy will have their cell phones confiscated until ~~close of the next school day and receive a demerit~~ the end of the day; their parents will be notified and will receive a detention and a demerit. Upon the second cell phone violation the student will receive a Saturday detention, a demerit, and the student's parent will be required to pick up the cell phone. Additional violations will be handled as repeated Category B Behavior.
