

Your Family Tree



You will create a representation of your own family tree.

Your tree will begin with the generation closest to 1900 and end with your own generation (or the next down if you have nieces/nephews).

You must have full names [first, middle, maiden last and married last name], birth and death dates, and connections to spouses, children, parents, etc on the chart. – Follow the proper way to construct a family tree.

You must have images for your immediate family (parents, siblings, you) and other photos of relatives are optional.

How to display? Posterboard (for help: <http://www.familytreetemplates.net/>)

How is it graded? See the rubric for points; this is a quiz grade

When is it due? Monday, April 18

How will it be presented? To the class in small groups and then displayed on the bulletin boards.
