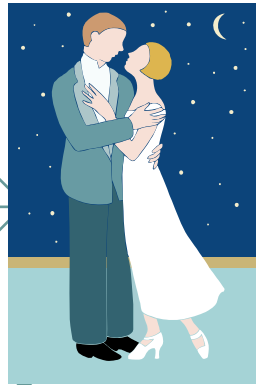

TRANSPORTATION

ALL STUDENTS MUST USE TRANSPORTATION PROVIDED BY ST. FRANCIS.

TICKET SALES: APRIL 21—APRIL 28

\$110 for individual tickets, or \$220 per couple, sold in the Student Union during C & E lunch.

Only Juniors or Seniors may purchase tickets. The enclosed Prom Parent Information sheet must also be signed and handed in when purchasing Prom tickets. Personal checks will be accepted but please no credit cards.

If you would like a vegetarian dinner please let us know when you purchase your tickets.

ATTENDANCE POLICY:

All students attending Prom must be in full attendance on Friday, April 30th.

SINGLE TICKET: \$110

All tickets will be sold as singles this year.
Only Juniors and Seniors may purchase tickets.

GUEST POLICY:

If a Junior or Senior would like to bring a guest who is not a student at St. Francis, the proper guest request form must be completed and handed in to the Dean's office prior to purchasing tickets. Guest Request forms are due **by 8:00 am April 29th. NO EXCEPTIONS.** Copies of the form are available in Student Services or may be downloaded from the St. Francis website.

PHOTOGRAPHER:

Root Studio will provide photography services for the evening. Be prepared to pay for your Prom pictures on the night of Prom. Brochures will be given when you purchase your tickets.

STUDENT GUIDELINES

Students attending Prom are required to comply with all St. Francis HS policies and procedures including:

No selling of, using of, possession of, or being under the influence of alcohol and/or any other drugs.

No smoking at Prom, on the premises of the Shedd Aquarium or on the buses.

If your date is not a St. Francis student, you are responsible for informing him/her of these regulations. (All regulations hold regardless of your date's age.)

As required by bus and public facility policies, students in possession of, or under the influence of, alcohol or other drugs will forfeit their ticket and are subject to arrest by the proper authorities.

Bags may be hand searched at the discretion of the chaperones.

Anyone suspected of being in violation of these regulations prior to Prom will not be admitted to the Prom. If a violation of these regulations occurs during Prom, your parents will be called and they will be required to pick you up.

GUYS REMEMBER TO:

1. Make sure you order your tuxedo well in advance.
2. Purchase your bow tie when renting your tuxedo, as it is a tradition for your date to keep it as a memento of the evening.
3. Order your date's corsage at least 4 to 5 days in advance, and don't forget to pick it up.
3. BE ON TIME!

GIRLS REMEMBER TO:

1. Buy your dress early for the best selection and make all necessary alterations. The style of dress should reflect SFHS values and modest attire. (See Main Bulletin Board)
2. Order your boutonniere at least 4 or 5 days in advance, and don't forget to pick it up.
